






How many years has your child participated in the Rocky Minor Hockey program? 114 responses




How many children do you have playing hockey, including Rec league?




How do you feel about the current team sizes in your division? Understanding smaller teams have a higher operating cost.




If there are 3 teams in a division, are you willing to have shared ice practices or a 2-1 practice week?





Would you be open to your child participating in morning practices before school/work a couple times a month?





Would you be for or against amalgamation with other associations to maintain a competitive balance? Travel for practices would be a requirement, up to an 80 km radius.



How reasonable do you feel the fundraising requirements are for your team/organization?




How would you rate the quality of leadership within the coaching staff?


How effective do you feel the player development is for younger players (if applicable)? 114 responses



Do you feel players have enough opportunities for personal and skill development? 114 responses






